# Pastor's Pondering...

Many individuals have ceased attending church for various reasons. Some find solace in televised worship, while others engage in personal devotions to God at home. Once, a regular churchgoer penned a letter to a newspaper editor, questioning the significance of attending church every Sunday. Despite three decades of listening to sermons, they confessed to an inability to recall any specific ones, sparking widespread discussion.

In response, someone offered an insightful analogy, likening the situation to not remembering what one ate for 30,000 meals over 30 years but still maintaining health and vigor. This comparison underscores that although specific sermons may fade from memory, the act of attending church nurtures our souls, akin to how meals nourish our bodies. Just as neglecting meals can lead to physical weakness, neglecting church attendance can result in spiritual frailty. It was an interesting article.

Attending church on Sundays encompasses more than listening to sermons with scripture readings, even though the Word and Sacrament are the center of gravity. It should have communal prayer and singing, offering, and wholehearted worship. Furthermore, fellowship with others and connection to the broader community are integral components. Thus, attending church imbues us with strength and vitality to foster connections with God and fellow believers so that we can serve God and our neighbor.

The Bible teaches that Jesus is the head of the church, and we are all part of its body. Without Jesus, our existence would lack purpose. While unforeseen circumstances may occasionally prevent us from attending church, our primary aim remains to honor and enjoy God forever.

Sincere and authentic worship is what God desires from us. Therefore, observing Sundays as sacred and set apart is crucial—it is one of God's commandments. Faith enables us to believe in the unseen and to receive blessings once deemed impossible. Let us, therefore, offer praise and gratitude to God in our worship Rev. Sarah Lee and in the conduct of our daily lives. Amen.
